The Gallery encourages, supports, and promotes the work of local artists in Belmont and surrounding communities. BMC is a vibrant media center with extensive hours open to the public & is an excellent venue for local art exhibitions.

The Gallery@BMC is another way in which BMC fulfills its mission of "Building Community Through Media". The Gallery Committee reviews works submitted by artists and chooses curators and jurors for group shows. In order to be considered as an exhibitor, the Committee will need a resume or biography and samples of your work. Please specify the dimensions of the original works. If you would prefer to show the committee original artwork, you may leave well-protected pieces at our facility. These will be ready for you to pick up in approximately two weeks, after the Gallery Committee has had a chance to review them.



If you are interested in serving as a curator or juror for an exhibit, please present your ideas and background information to the Gallery Committee.

The Gallery Committee will also hold special exhibits for students, Senior Citizen groups, and non-profit organizations. These will be curated by an appropriate contact for that group. Suggestions can be made to members of the Gallery Committee.

There is a \$25 fee for professional artist to exhibit their work in the Gallery, to cover the cost of renewable supplies. Artists are responsible for hanging and removing their show, as well as planning and hosting the opening reception. Invitations and printed promotional materials are also the responsibility of the artist and must be approved by the Gallery Committee to ensure accuracy of information. BMC receives a 10% commission on any work sold during the exhibit. All exhibitors are required to sign a "Hold Harmless" agreement with BMC, as there is no insurance coverage provided.

The Gallery will promote your exhibit through local press, email listsery, and the electronic Community Bulletin Board on BMC channels 96/30. BMC volunteers may produce a TV segment about the artist(s). Information will be posted on our website at **belmontmedia.org**
